

3/4" wrench, socket & ratchet (2) 9/16" wrenches Feeler gauges Torque wrench capable of 100 ft-lbs. of torque

<u>Removal</u>

- 1. Remove 1/2" lock nuts labeled "3"
- 2. Remove 1/2" hex bolts labeled "2" and washers labeled "1"
- 3. Spacer assembly should drop from the bottom labeled "4"
- 4. Discard these parts



Installation

- 1. Do not re-use old parts, use new parts supplied in service kit.
- 2. Install spacer assembly "4" under rail assembly in same orientation as shown above.
- 3. Place new flat washers "1" onto new hex bolts "2".
- 4. Insert bolt and washer set through housing holes "A" and bushings "B".
- 5. Thread lock nuts "3" onto bolts "2" and torque to 75 lbs.-ft.

Bolt Gap Adjustment

- 1. Loosen lock nut "1".
- 2. Using feeler gauge, set gap space as shown below.
- 3. Holding Bolt "2" securely, tighten nut "1" to "jam" bolt in place.
- 4. Re-check gap.
- 5. Check the movement of the "16K Husky-10" to ensure movement fore and aft is not hindered.
