INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR GLASS COVERS **MODEL SDN3**

WARNING! Improper installation, adjustment, alteration, service or maintenance can cause property damage, personal injury or loss of life. 1. Ensure that you have the minimum counter top opening available per chart below. If you do not have this much counter space available, this accessory will not fit. Do not proceed any further.



2. Make sure that you have at least 5 $^{1}/_{8}$ inches of depth below the counter top that is open. This installation will recess the burner box into the cabinet.


- 3. Place the trim piece upside down on the counter top. Be sure to maintain the following minimum dimensions illustrated below. Trace the outline of the trim piece on the counter. Offset another line $\frac{3}{8}$ to the inside of the tracing. This new line will be for the counter top cut. Be sure to trace lines that can later be cleaned off the counter.
- 4. Be sure to maintain the following minimum dimensions illustrated below for the cut-out tracing.

- **5.** Cut the counter top along the inner line.
- **6.** Place trim piece into the cutout. Ensure the arrow is pointing to the front of the counter top. Secure to the cabinet with three (3) screws provided.
- **7.** Install drop-in cook top per manufacturer's instructions. Drop-in will now mount to trim piece.

WARNING! Make sure that the knobs are positioned closest to the front of the cabinet so that the user is NOT required to reach over a burner in order to reach a knob.

8. The glass cover is not to be in place while the burners are on.

WARNING! Never use cover over drop-in cook top when any burners are in operation.
