



## Stay Charge Installation Manual

August 2017



Using the attached bracket, mount the terminal housing on or near rear bumper of truck. Route the cables from there up to the front of the vehicle to the battery. Be sure to keep cables clear of heat, moving parts, and sharp edges. Secure cables using clamps or wire ties.(not provided) If there is excess cable at the battery, they can be cut to the desired length. Crimp cable ends on the wires and add heat shrink. Connect the red cable to the breaker and then connect the short red cable between breaker and battery positive post. The last step is to connect the black cable to the negative post on the battery.
