



C. RV Requirements


DM-4718 security door lock is designed for RVs with wall thickness of 1-1/4" to 1-3/8" (32 - 35 mm). For wall thickness other than those listed, installer must acquire suitable length mounting screws.

INSTALLATION


- Plan and determine location to mount door lock, considering available space, both inside and outside, as well as position of accessories, such as fly screens, etc.
 - Security door lock can be mounted on either a left-hand or right-hand door. See (FIG. 1).




2. Determine whether lock will be mounted horizontally or vertically. See (FIG. 1) and (FIG. 2).



 Select the correct horizontal or vertical 2-3/4" x 4-13/16" gasket. NOTE: The arrow cut-outs of the gasket are to point upward upon assembly. See (FIG. 3).



- Align hole cut-outs of template with holes of gasket, noting arrow direction (upward).
- Remove sticky-back template from paper backing and apply to pre-determined mount location on outside of RV wall. See (FIG. 4).



- 6. Using a pencil, mark the (4) holes of the template. See (FIG. 4).
- 7. Remove the template.
- 8. AWARNING FIRE OR ELECTRICAL SHOCK HAZARD. Make sure there are no obstacles (wires, pipes, etc.) inside RV's [roof / floor / walls]. Shut OFF gas supply, disconnect 120 Vac power from RV, and disconnect positive (+) 12 Vdc terminal from supply battery BEFORE drilling or cutting into RV. Failure to obey these warnings could result in death or serious injury. Drill (2) 1/2" diameter holes and (2) 1/4" diameter through holes as marked. See (FIG. 4).
- NOTICE ALWAYS use sealant on (clean) parts and surfaces where fasteners enter RV's [walls / roof / floor]. Otherwise, water leakage could occur.


INSTALLATION

Apply sealant into the (2) screw holes. See (FIG. 5).


 Assemble the selected gasket to the outside lock unit, aligning holes of gasket with holes of lock unit. See (FIG. 5).



NOTE: Incorrect gasket selection or orientation may result in water leakage.




- Assemble outside lock unit, with gasket, to mounting location, ensuring breather slot is facing downward. See (FIG. 5).
- Assemble small gasket to inside lock unit, aligning holes of gasket with holes of lock unit. See (FIG. 6).



13. Assemble inside lock unit, with gasket, to outside lock unit, aligning with square shafts. See (FIG. 6).



When assembling, with key removed and locking plate locked into any position, align cut-out of thumb turn with screw hole, and align long lobe of inside lever the same direction as locking plate. See (FIG. 7).



Secure units with (1) short and (1) long screw.
 Note location of each. See (FIG. 6).



NOTE: Hand tighten screws.

- Apply (2) plugs to holes, covering screws. See (FIG. 6).
- 16. Installation is now complete.
