## **Quick Instructions**

## MANUAL OPERATION

You'll need to manually operate your jacks.
Refer to your manual.



#### 2 IS BETTER THAN 1

Grab a helper. One operate the controls & one to line up your SnapPad.

#### CONFIRMATION

After completion visually confirm the lip is fully engaged.



**1. Line 'em up.**Raise your jacks and line up your
SnapPads.



2. Lower jacks.
Lower your jacks,
stop and readjust to
make sure they line
up.



**3. 'Snap'**Continue applying pressure until the lip snaps into place.

## 5th Wheel Detailed Instructions

Installation time: 3 - 6 minutes per pad.

## \*\*\*Important Notes\*\*\*

- 1. Snap Pad installation should be performed on a level or near level surface -- preferably a hard surface (concrete or asphalt). Wheel chocks should be placed in front of and behind the RV wheels for additional safety.
- 2.\*\*\*SnapPads MUST FIRST BE INSTALLED ON THE FRONT JACKS (landing gear) before continuing to the rear 2 or 4 leveling jacks. Front jack installation must be done while the RV is hitched up to the truck. For safety, also connect the RV's break-away cable to the truck before installation.\*\*\*
- **3.** As front jacks generally extend one-at-a-time, it is recommended that SnapPad be installed on the landing jack pad that will touch the ground first.
- 4. \*\*\*Spread a small bead of concentrated dish soap or grease around the lip of the SnapPad and metal landing foot to aid in installation.\*\*\* (Wipe excess away once installation is complete)
- **5.** In most systems, once the first landing jack pad develops enough pressure against the SnapPad, the other landing jack will extend. Keep a watchful eye on the second landing jack pad as it extends. Stop extending it when the pad is about 3 to 4 inches from the ground. \*\*\*KEEP YOUR FINGERS AND ANY FOREIGN OBJECTS CLEAR WHEN LOWERING THE JACK INTOPLACE.\*\*\*
- **6.** Carefully place and center the second SnapPad under the landing jack pad. Begin to extend the front landing jacks until the second pad touches the SnapPad. If you feel that either landing pad is not centered on the SnapPads, retract the landing gear enough to recenter the SnapPads and proceed with extending the landing gear to complete the SnapPad installation.
- 7.\*\*\*Once SnapPad installation is complete on the front landing jacks, the TRUCK MUST BE DISCONNECTED AND PULLED AWAYED from the RV before installing SnapPads on the rear 2 or 4 leveling jack pads.\*\*\*
- **8.** Wipe off any excess soap or grease and repeat installation process, in sequence, on the remaining jacks.

## **Motorhome Detailed Instructions**

Installation time: 3 - 6 minutes per pad.

## \*\*\*Important Notes\*\*\*

- 1. Snap Pad installation is best performed on a level or near level surface preferably a hard surface (concrete or asphalt). Wheel chocks can be placed in front of and behind the RV wheels for additional safety.
- 2. \*\*\*Most motorhomes will release their airbags prior to engaging the jacks. This will lower the entire RV at the beginning of the leveling process. You may place your first SnapPad prior to this however be careful to not get caught underneath your RV during the lowering process!\*\*\*
- 3. \*\*\*Spread a small bead of concentrated dish soap or grease around the lip of the SnapPad and metal landing foot to aid in installation.\*\*\*
- **4.** Generally one side will level first, take note which side that is and start there. Install one SnapPad at a time.
- **5.** Most jacks are 18" 24" under your RV. Use a tool such as a broomstick to align your SnapPad may be necessary.
- 6. Keep a watchful eye on the landing foot as it extends. Stop extending when the foot is about 3 to 4 inches from the your SnapPad. Double check to make sure it is centered. Re-align if necessary and then continue extending the landing gear to complete installation. \*\*\*KEEP YOUR FINGERS AND ANY FOREIGN OBJECTS CLEAR WHEN LOWERING THE JACK INTO PLACE.\*\*\*
- 7. You should hear a distinctive 'Snap' as the lip engages. \*\*\*Visually confirm the lip is fully engaged around the perimeter of the landing foot.\*\*\*
- 8. If your lip hasn't fully engaged raise your jack and place a shim (small piece of wood) under the side that hasn't engaged. Lower your jack again until that side snaps into place.
- **6.** Wipe off any excess soap or grease and repeat installation process, in sequence, on the remaining jacks.

## **Helpful Hints**

- It's best (and easiest) to install your SnapPads one at a time on a level, hard surface.
- Each leveling system will have it's own manual operation function. Please refer to your owners manual for specific directions.
- Grab a helper! It's safer, faster, and more efficient with two people.
- Install each SnapPad individually and visually confirm the reinforced lip has engaged on the complete diameter. It is critical your SnapPad has been installed fully and correctly.


## **SnapPad Info & Statistics**

- Dimensions 11" Wide x 11"Long x 1.83" Thick
- Once installed they add an extra 1.125" to your jack thickness
- 4.8 Lbs. per Pad

## **TIPS & TRICKS**

We recommend covering your jacks landing feet with a rubberized protectant such as FlexSeal (yes the sealant from the television ads) to complete the look and double protect your jacks! Make sure to cover your jack cylinders prior to applying and coat the bottom of your landing feet as well.



## **SAFETY**

Your SnapPad's have been tested to withstand over 50x the force of gravity. Which means you could hit the biggest pothole of your life at 60 MPH and your SnapPads will remain firmly fasten to your jacks.
