

# **BLUE OX®** Installation Instructions TC5501 Bracket Kit

Serial No.

The TC35270 steering control unit is recommended for use with this bracket kit.

- 1. Set front wheels of vehicle in straight ahead position.
- 2. Remove nuts from axle spring rear U-bolt on driver's side. Bracket must clear above or below tie rod by at least 1/2" if rear mount.
- 3. Install item 2 on to axle and reinstall the existing washers and nuts. Tighten to manufacturers specs.
- 4. Install item 3 on tie rod using items 4 and 7 (choose the appropriate U-Bolts for your application), according to drawing on page 2. DO NOT TIGHTEN. Item 3 may be rotated or flipped to insure steering control (Item 1) remains parallel to the ground. Torque bolts to 30 ft. lbs.
- 5. Install solenoid end of Item 1 to top of Anchor Bracket (Item 2) with Items 5, 6, 8 and 9, according to drawing on page 2.
- 6. Install small end of TruCenter unit (Item 1) to top of Tie Rod Bracket with Items 5, 6, 8 and 9, see drawing on page 2. Allow enough slack for the Tie Rod Bracket (Item 3) to rotate for alignment to the tie rod. DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN.
- 7. Tighten items 5, 6, 8, and 9 on Anchor Bracket (Item 2) to 180-200 ft/lbs of torque.
- 8. Rotate item 3 around the tie rod until the small diameter end of the TruCenter is 1/2" to 1" lower than the solenoid end of the unit.
- 9. Tighten Items 4 and 7 on the Tie Rod Bracket (Item 3) to 25-35 ft/lbs of torque.
- 10. Tighten Items 5, 6, 8, and 9 on the Tie Rod Bracket (Item 3) to 180-200 ft/lbs of torque.

Check to be sure installed unit clears all other parts of vehicle by turning steering wheel to both extreme right and left positions. If unit scrapes or binds at any point, make necessary corrections by rotating unit on tie rod to obtain necessary clearance.

Install TruCenter Steering Control wiring according to instructions included in its package.

#### 12. DEALER OR INSTALLER: BE CERTAIN USER RECEIVES INSTRUCTION SHEET.


Insure that you use the proper TruCenter steering control unit for your application. Using too strong or too weak of a steering control may result in improper or undesirable handling.
