



Solar Globe Instructions





Assembly:

Line up On/Off Button on Battery Cover. Place down; no screwing of battery cover is necessary.
Screw Seal Ring down over Battery Cover.









Operation:

- Press the Button to the "ON"..... press again to turn "OFF"
- Turn "OFF" for storage; this will greatly extend the life of the batteries.
- Globe automatically turns itself "OFF" when exposed to light.
- For best results you should try to ensure that the installation allows full access to the sun.

TroubleShooting:

- Problem: Light does not come on at all.
 - o Another light source: Street Lights simulate daylight, could prevent the Globe from turning on.
 - Check the on/off Button is in the "ON".
 - o Replace Rechargeable Batteries with regular "AAA" Batteries, place Globe into a dark space:
 - If Globe does not light up on regular batteries, then it is defective.
 - If Globe does lights up on regular batteries, then it may be that the Rechargeable Batteries need a "Jump Start".

Jump Start: The green rechargeable batteries sometimes require a "Jump Start" to get the recharging cycle going. To perform this, use a "D" cell battery, put "+" to "+" or "positive" to "positive" and run a wire to the "negatives" of each battery. Hold this for 15 to 30 seconds then replace batteries into Globe and let them charge.

- If the "Jump Start" didn't work then Green rechargeable batteries are defective.
- Problem: Light comes on for just for a short time each night.
 - Solution: More Sunlight or Batteries are not charging, replace the rechargeable batteries.

WARNING: Do not dispose of any RECHARGEABLE batteries in the regular trash, municipal waste, stream or by fire as batteries may leak or explode. Do not open, short circuit, or mutilate batteries as injury may occur. Preserve our environment by recycling rechargeable batteries, or disposing them in accordance with Local, State and Federal regulations.
